Source Designation	<u>Title V</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to the Operating Permit Program contained in Chapter 173-401 WAC. Facility emissions are greater than 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, greater than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and/or greater than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application to modify certain aspects of their existing permit including monitoring requirements and emission averaging at the above described facility. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: PM, PM10, NO <sub>x</sub> , SO <sub>2</sub> , CO, VOC
Public Comment Period	A 30 day public comment period will be provided for this application/permit pursuant to SWCAA 400-171(3). When complete, a copy of the draft permit will be made available at the SWCAA business office and posted on the SWCAA permit webpage ( <a href="http://www.swcleanair.org/permitsprelim.html">www.swcleanair.org/permitsprelim.html</a> ). A notice announcing the draft permit will be published in a local newspaper.

Comments must be submitted to SWCAA in writing prior to the end of the designated public comment period; or</li> <li>• Request a public hearing for the draft permit. Public hearing requests must be received by SWCAA in writing during the designated public comment period, indicate the interest of the person filing the request, and state why a hearing is warranted. A public hearing will be held if the Control Officer determines that significant public interest exists.</li> </ul>
