Affected Facility	Pacific Power and Light/Merwin 105 Merwin Village Ct. Ariel, WA 98603
Description of Facility	Hydroelectric power generation facility
Source Designation	The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions will be less than 100 tons per year (tpy) of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for installation of an emergency backup generator for use in powering spillway gates in the event of a power failure at the above described facility. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: Nitrogen Oxides, Carbon Monoxide, Particulate Matter, Volatile Organic Compounds, and Sulfur Dioxide
Public Comment Period	A thirty (30) day public comment period will be provided upon request for this application/permit pursuant to SWCAA 400-171(3).
