- Burn firewood that has been split, stacked and dried for at least 6 months with a moisture content of 20% or less.
- Join the Southwest Clean Air Agency e-mail list to stay informed about Air Pollution Advisories, Fire Safety Burn Bans and receive e-notifications when a Wood Stove / Fireplace Curtailment (Burn Ban) is in effect.
- Always check before I burn to see if a Burn Ban is in effect.
- To not burn when a Burn Ban is in effect (unless wood is my *only* adequate source of heat) until local air quality returns to healthy levels and the ban is lifted.
